In response to the recent outbreak of Novel Coronavirus Covid-19 in SA

"Nothing can separate us from the love of God" (Romans 8:38,39)

On Monday, 16 November 2020, the Premier announced that from midnight on Monday, 16 November 2020 gatherings for worship will be limited to 100 people, and the 1 person per 4 square metre rule was to be reapplied, with the restrictions to apply for a two week period initially.

During the previous period of lockdown earlier this year, Church Council and Pastor Joe agreed that we could not recommence worship services with this level of restriction. Upon consideration, we again feel that given the severity of this pandemic, worship at Lobethal will be suspended for the next two Sundays while the situation in our state clarifies.

For those who have access to the internet, please access if you wish the services currently available online (Melissa will list those resources in the bulletin for you during this time). For those who do not have access to the internet, Pastor Joe's sermon and some worship material will be available on the radio via Radio FM 88. As before, we will also be updating our webpage and Facebook page with worship and other resources you may access during this time.

Again, please stay safe and well, look after your families and support each other in your community via phone, social media and most importantly, prayer. We pray that this outbreak may be contained quickly without impacting seriously on those infected, and also that it may cause only a brief interruption to our worship life.

A further update will follow as more is known of this event.
